## Survey Methodology

---

- Conducted November 8-December 2, 2024, among a representative sample of 5,772 adults who are part of the Ipsos KnowledgePanel. The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 1.7 percentage points.
- The survey includes a subsample of 4,757 voters who reported voting in the 2024 presidential election. The margin of error for the voter subsample is +/- 1.9 percentage points.

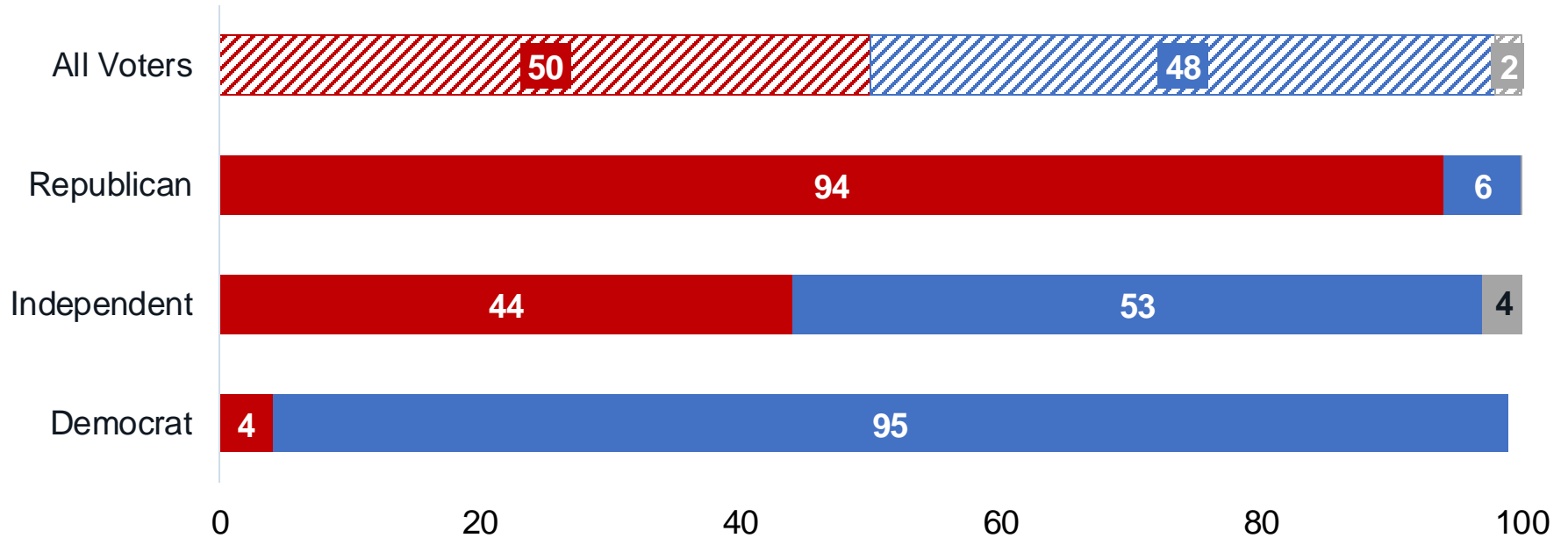

Percent who voted for \_\_\_\_\_ in the November 2024 election:

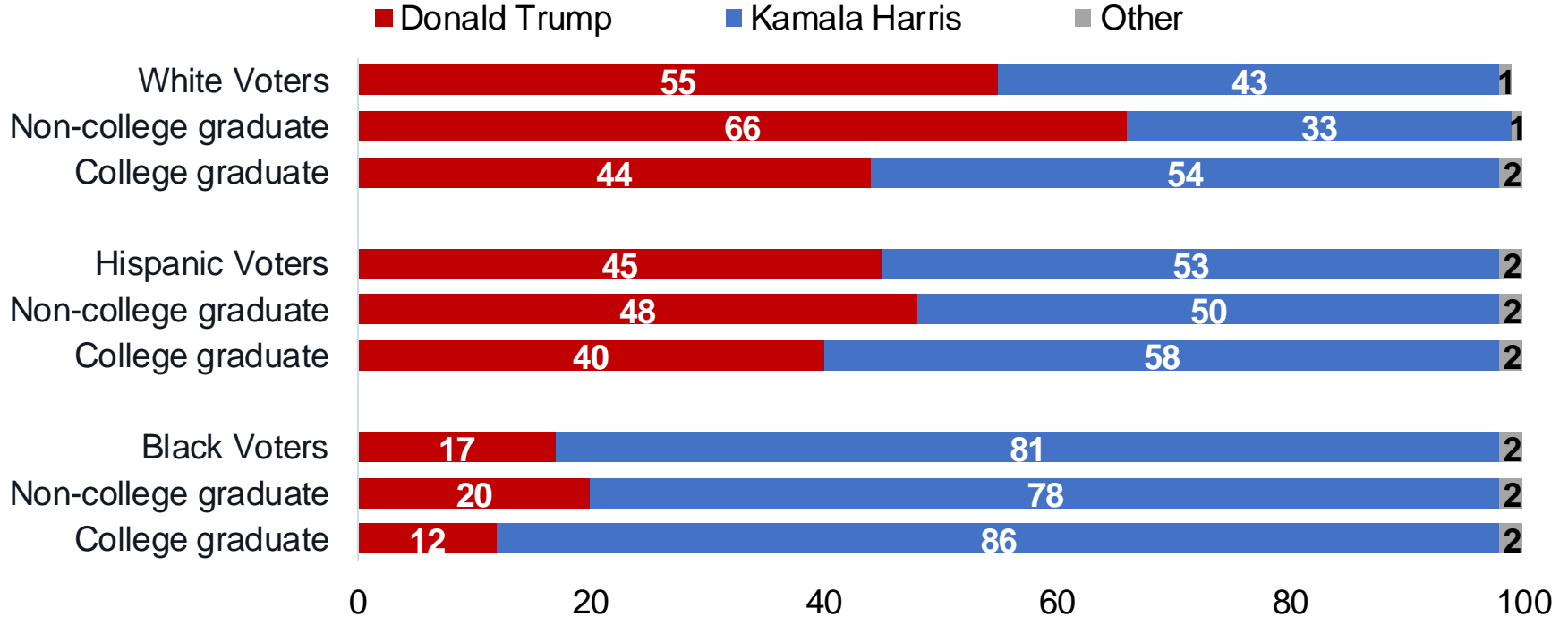
■ Donald Trump      ■ Kamala Harris      ■ Other

# Presidential Vote, by Race and Education

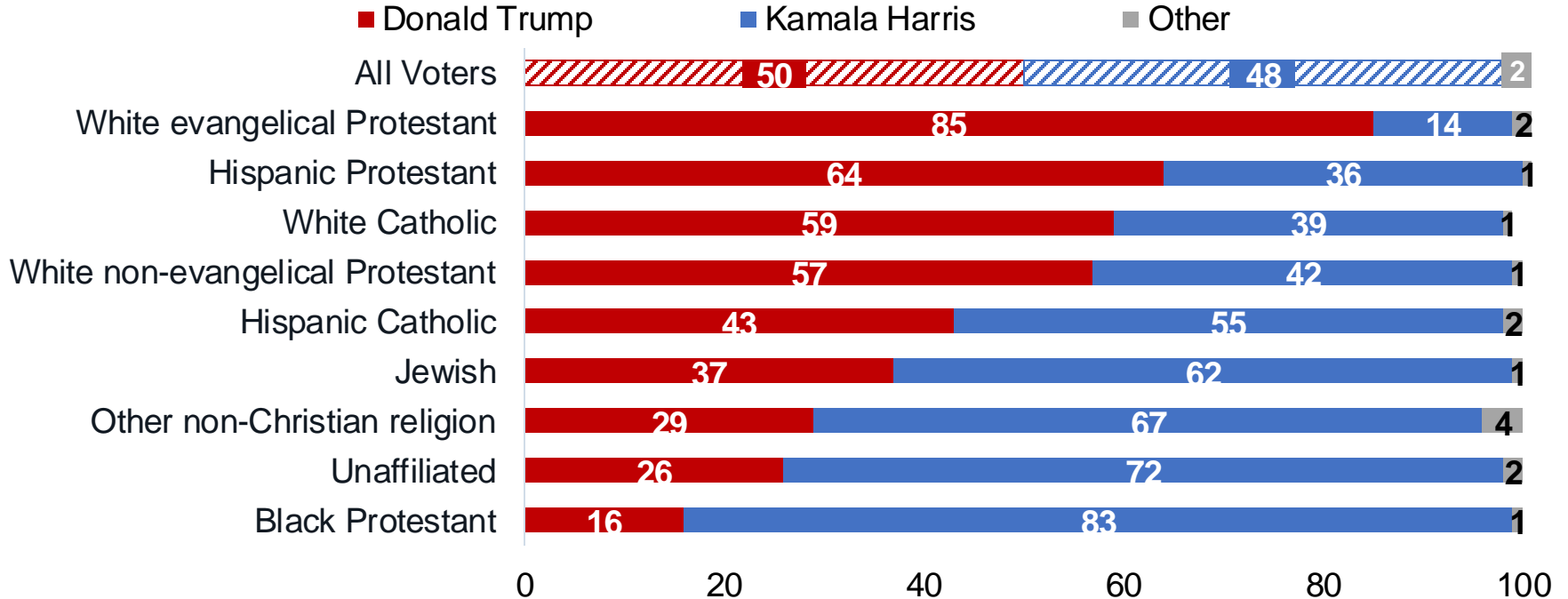
Percent who voted for \_\_\_\_\_ in the November 2024 election:

Percent who voted for \_\_\_\_\_ in the November 2024 election:

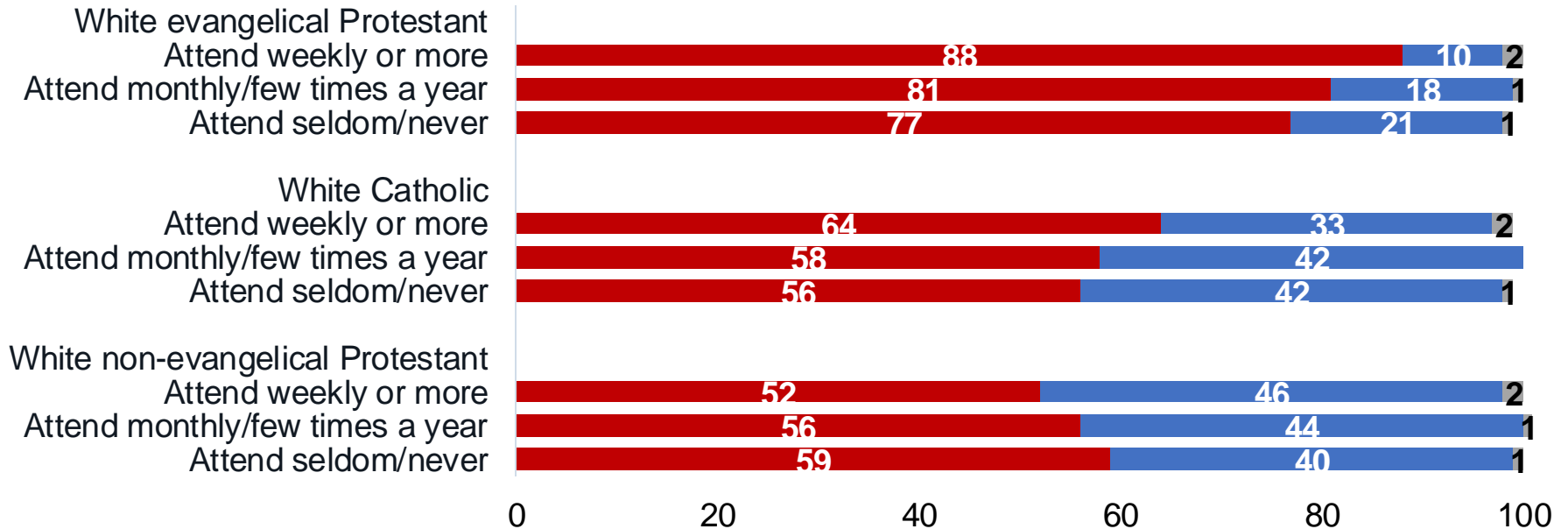

Percent who voted for \_\_\_\_ in the November 2024 election:

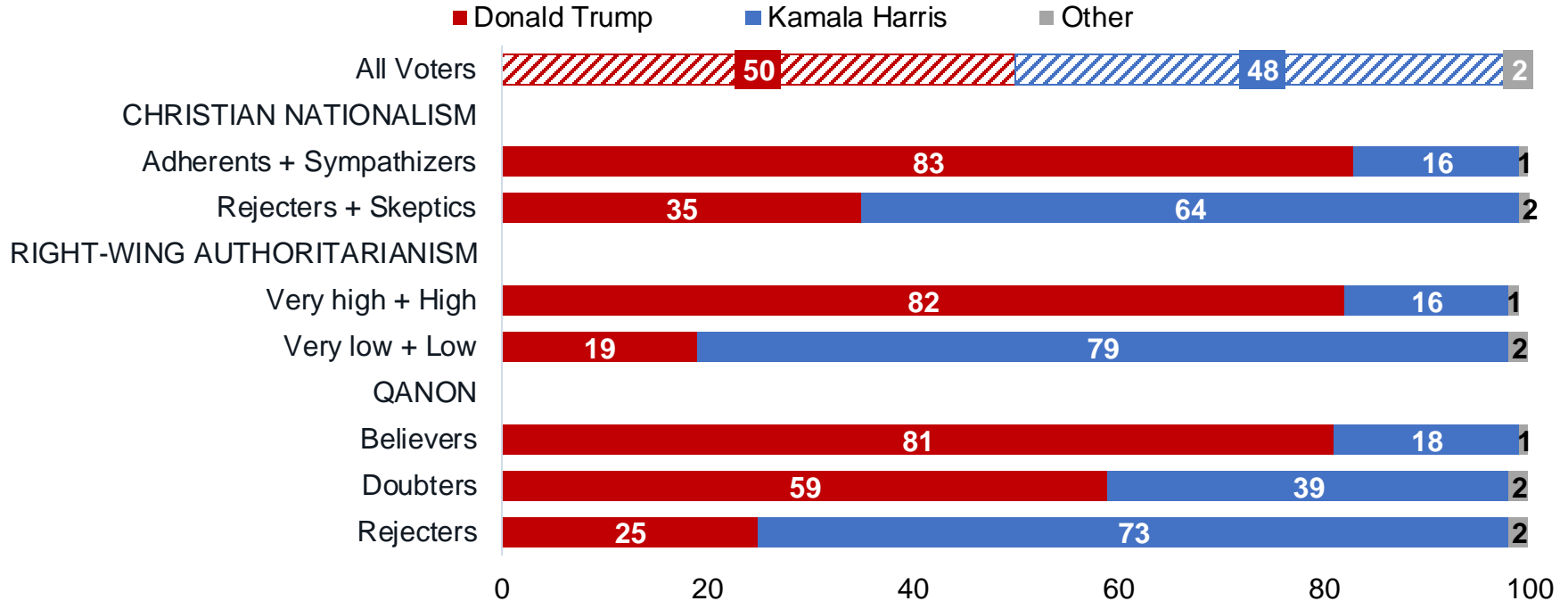

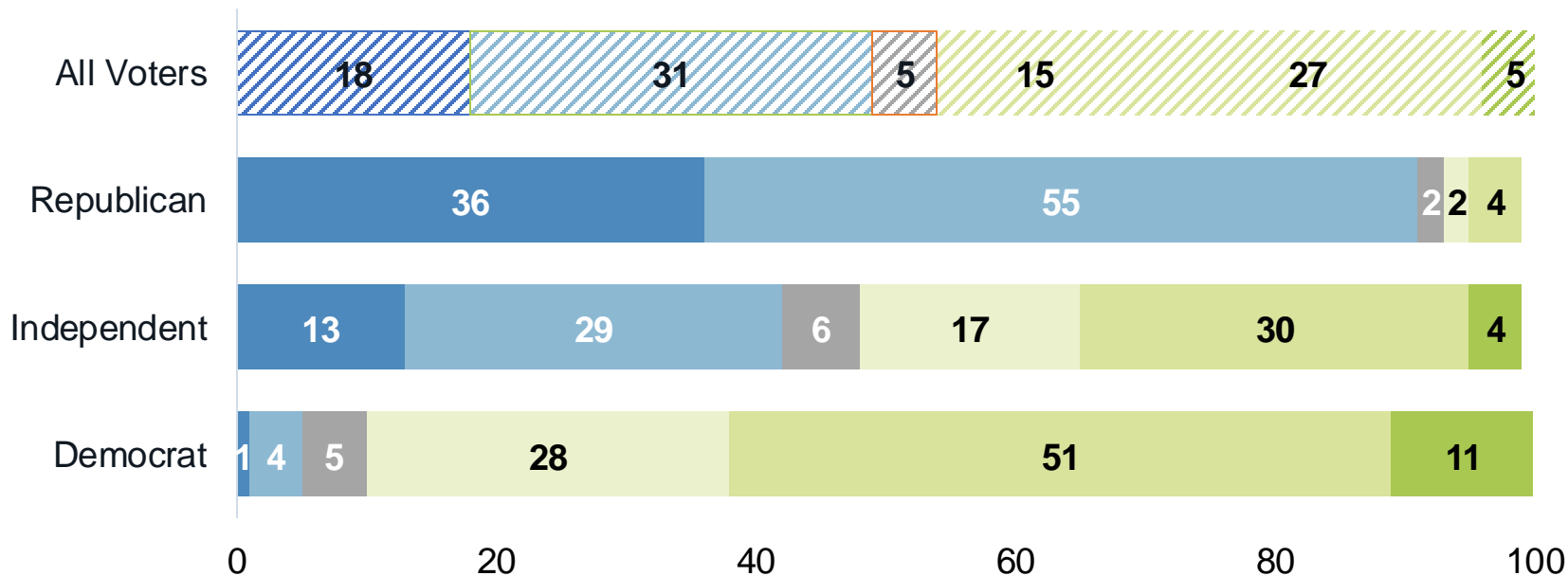

■ Excited ■ Satisfied ■ Other ■ Disappointed ■ Worried ■ Angry

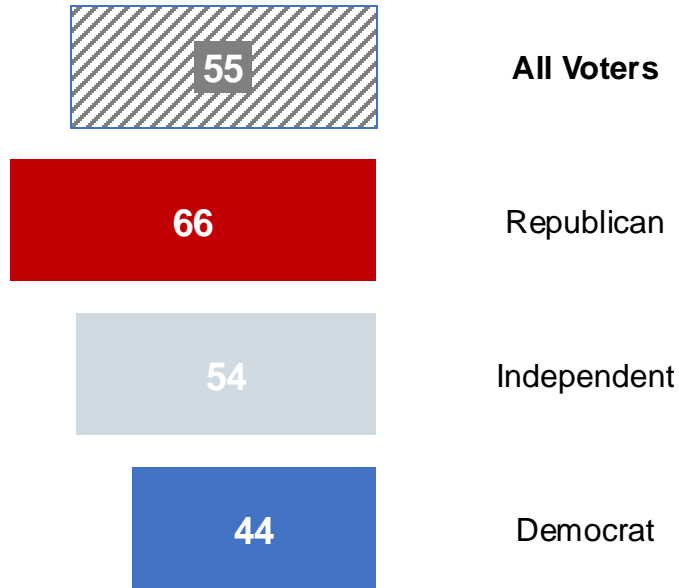

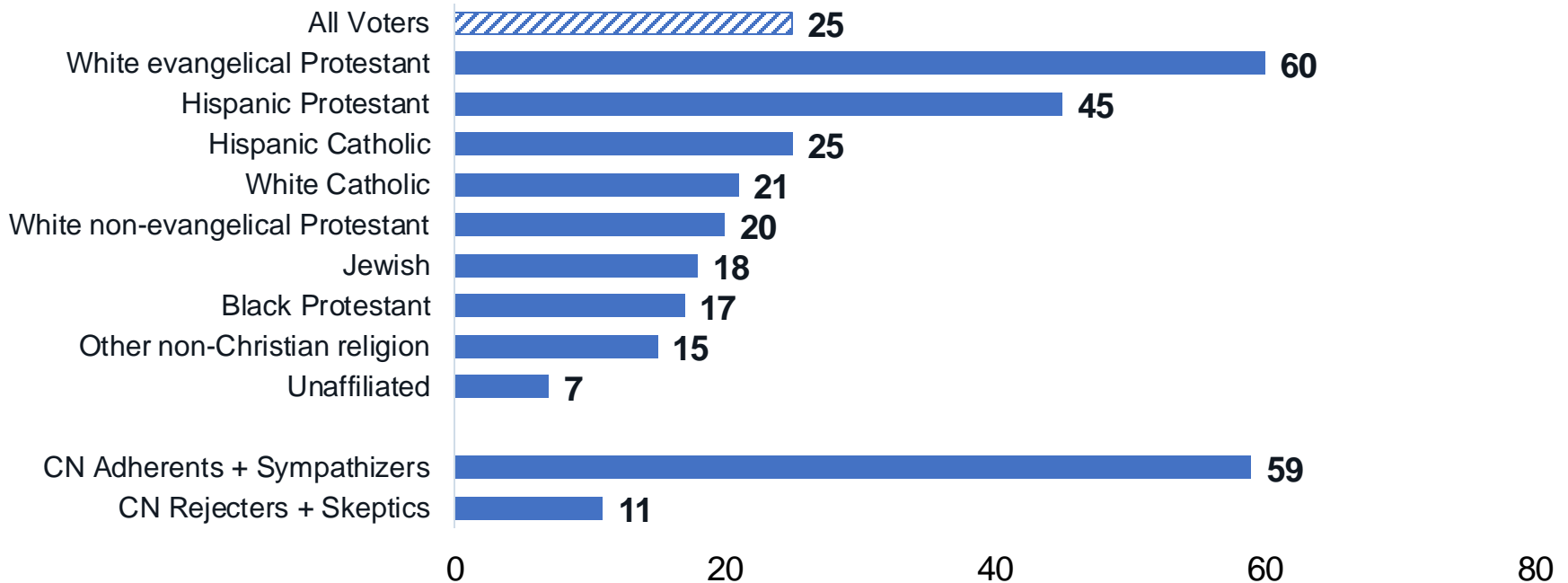
Very confident 2024 election was conducted fairly and accurately

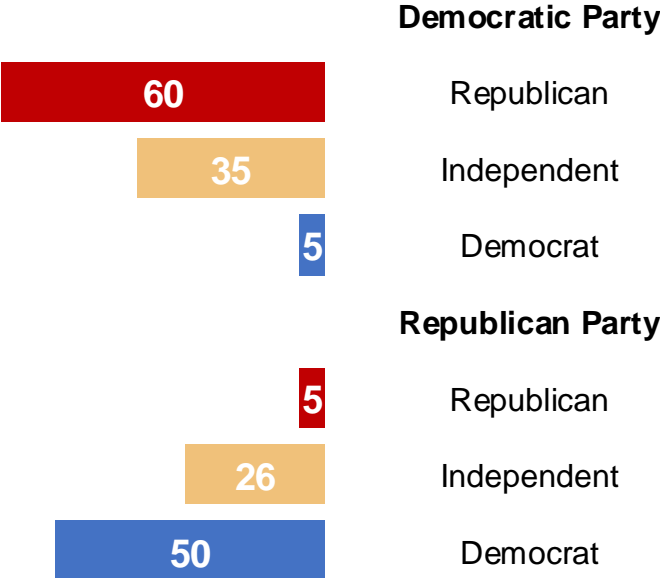

Percent who say the \_\_\_\_ poses a serious threat:

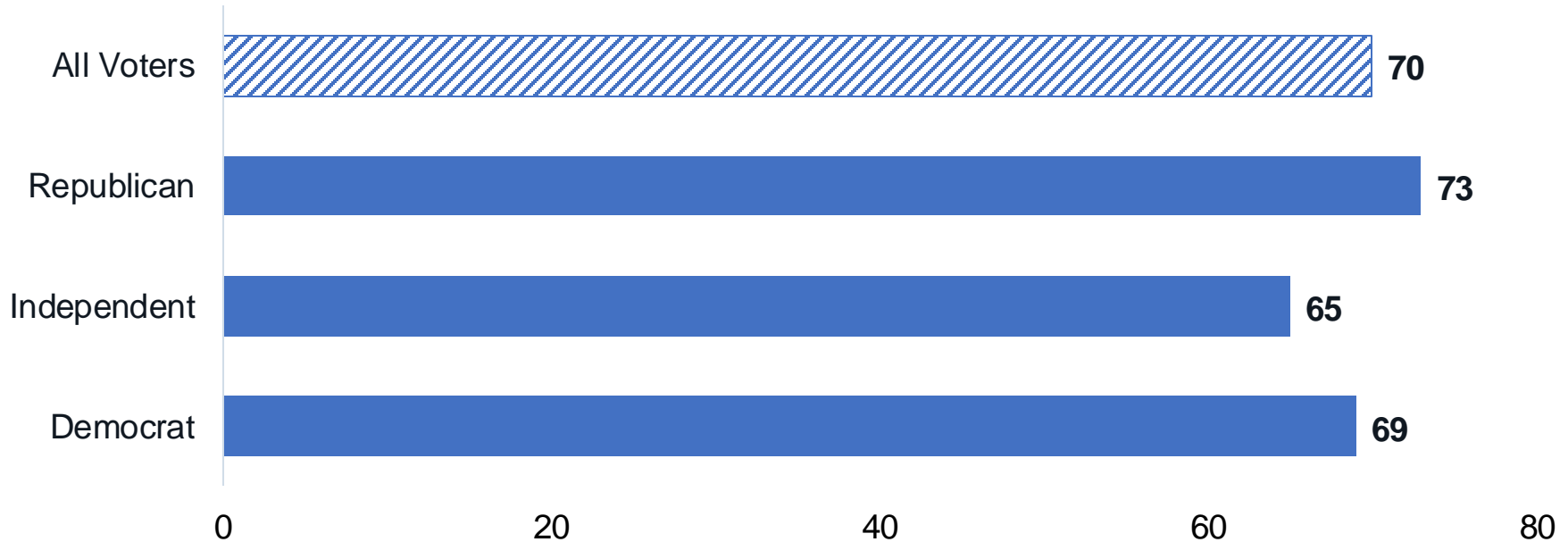

## Dangers of Enemies Within, By Party Affiliation

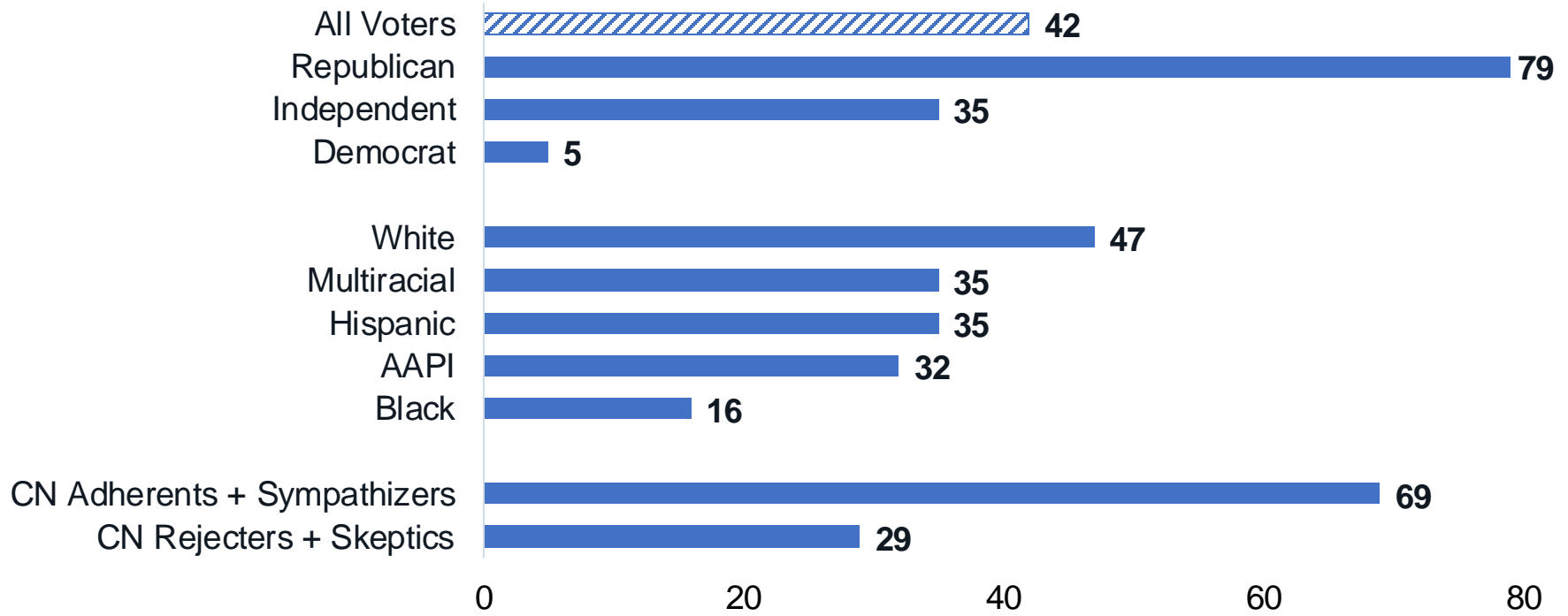
*In America today, the biggest dangers we face are not from outsiders but from those living among us who want to destroy our country:*

*Very confident our democracy will remain strong over the next four years:*

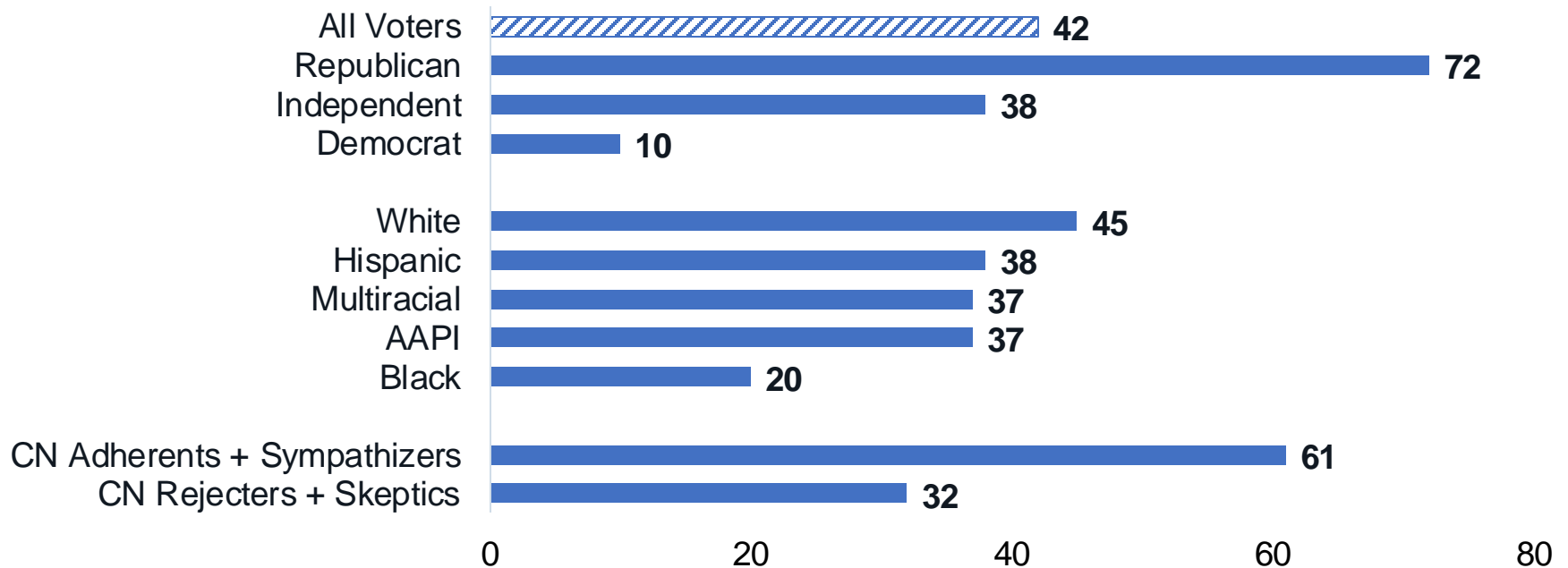

# Americans Will Be Able to Freely Express Their Opinions, By Party Affiliation, Race, and Christian Nationalism

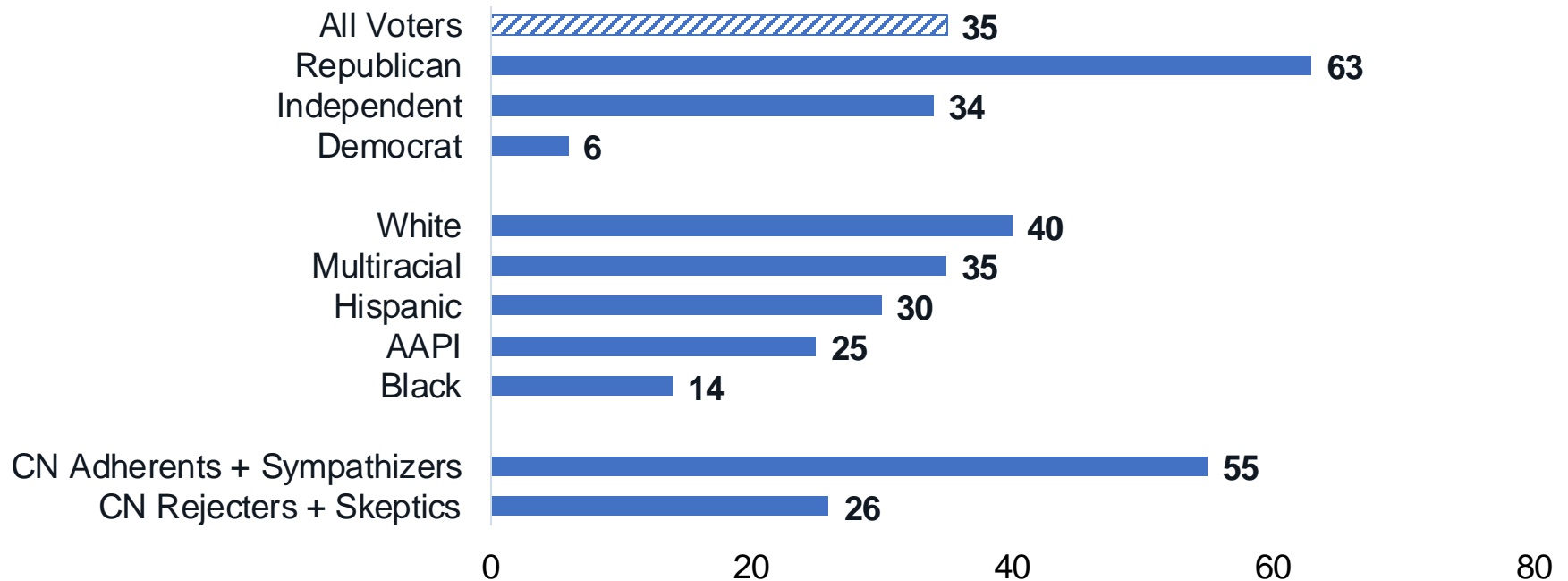
*Very confident Americans will be able to freely express their political opinions, even if they differ from the incoming presidential administration:*

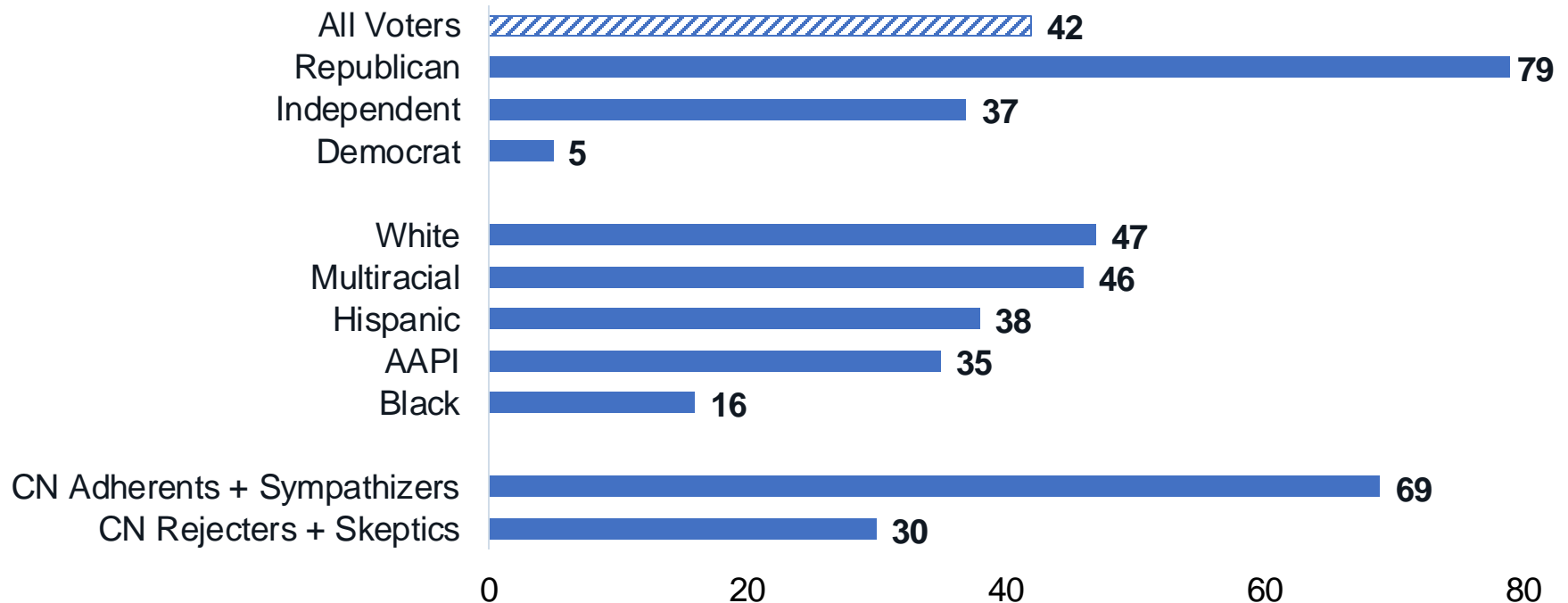

*Very confident Donald Trump will peacefully leave office at the end of his term:*



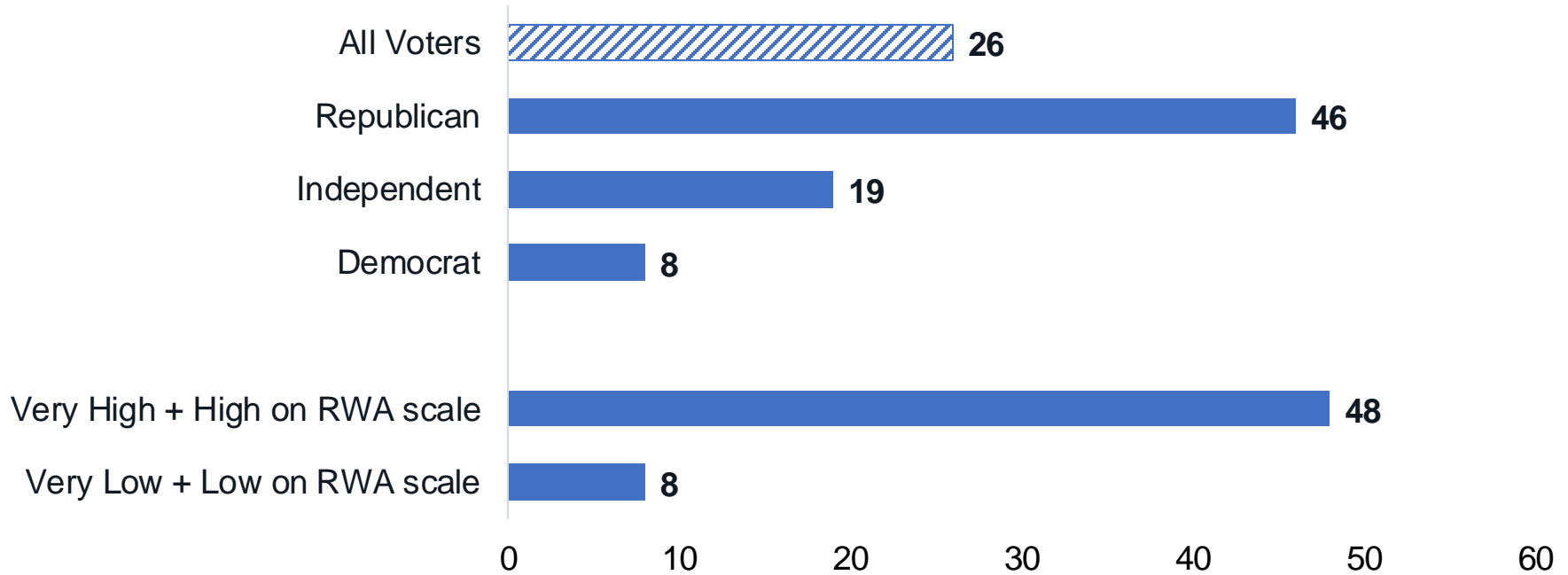

*The U.S. military should put immigrants who are in the country illegally into internment camps until they can be deported:*



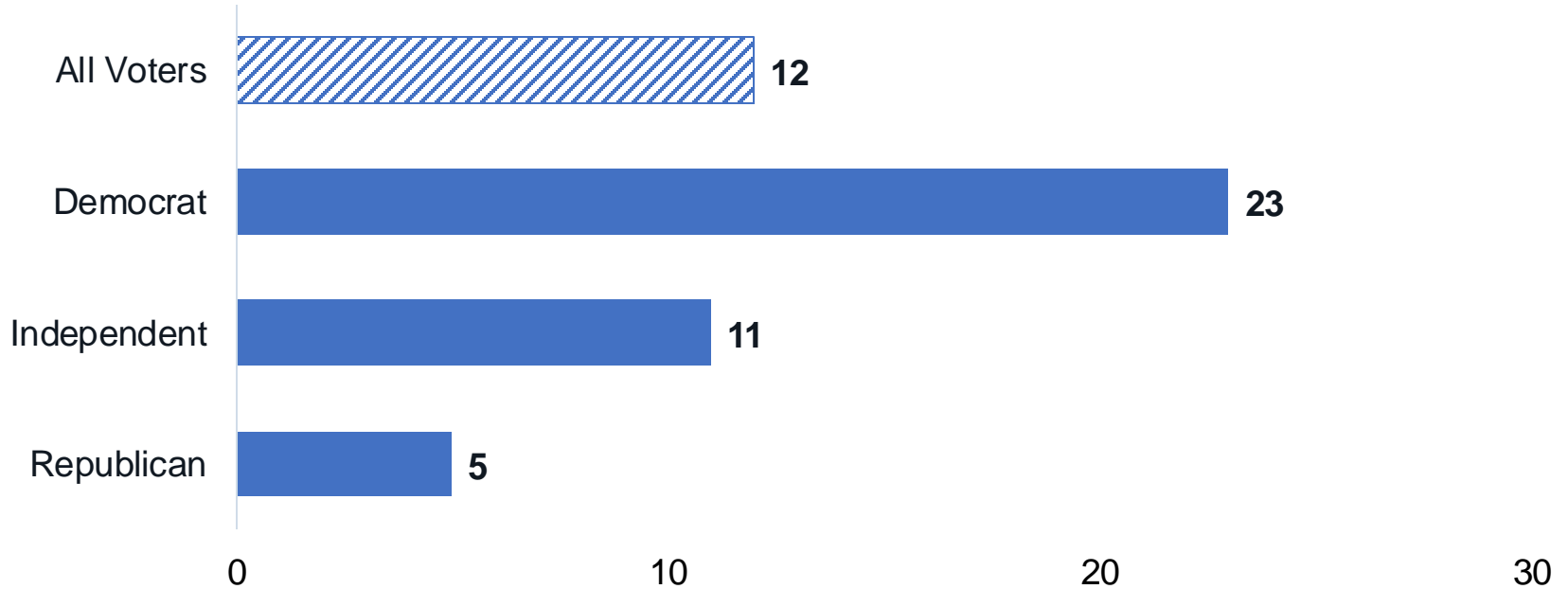
