Survey Methodology

- Conducted February 28-December 8, 2025, among a probability sample of 20,771 adults who are part of the Ipsos KnowledgePanel plus 1,340 state level opt-in oversamples, for a total sample of 22,111 adults.
- The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 0.87 percentage points and has a design effect of 1.7.
- The survey was made possible through the generous support of the Wilbur & Hilda Glenn Family Foundation, the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation, and the Unitarian Universalist Veatch Program at Shelter Rock.


A LOOK AT LGBTQ AMERICANS

LGBTQ Identity

- One in ten Americans (10%) identify as part of the LGBTQ community; this includes 3% as gay or lesbian, 4% as bisexual, and 2% as “something else.”
- Two in ten Americans ages 18-29 (20%) identify as LGBTQ, followed by 11% ages 30-49, 5% ages 50-64, and 4% ages 65 and older.

Percent of _____ who identify as:





Support for Nondiscrimination Protections, 2015-2025, by Party


Percent who favor nondiscrimination laws for LGBTQ people:

Support Nondiscrimination Protections, by Religious Affiliation


Percent who favor nondiscrimination laws for LGBTQ people:

Percent who support nondiscrimination protections:



Opposition to Religiously Based Refusals, 2015-2025, by Party


Percent who oppose allowing a small business owner in your state to refuse to provide products or services to gay or lesbian people if doing so would violate their religious beliefs:

Opposition to Religiously Based Refusals, by Religious Affiliation



Percent who oppose allowing a small business owner to refuse to provide products or services to gay or lesbian people, if doing so violates their religious beliefs:



Support for Same-Sex Marriage, 2015-2025, by Party


Percent who support allowing same-sex marriage:

Support for Same-Sex Marriage, by Religious Affiliation


Percent who support allowing same-sex marriage:

Percent who support allowing same-sex marriage:



Views on Transgender Rights and Protections, by Party


Percent who _____ that transgender people deserve the same rights and protections as other Americans:

Percent who _____ that transgender people deserve the same rights and protections as other Americans:



Views on Laws Requiring Transgender Individuals to Use Bathrooms That Correspond to Their Sex at Birth, 2016-2025, by Party


Percent who favor laws that require transgender individuals to use bathrooms that correspond to their sex at birth rather than their current gender identity:
